- A forest school leader has been successfully trained (Level 3) and appointed, and currently works 5 mornings a week. First Aid training has also been completed.
- Each year group has at least 5 sessions of Forest School per year.
- Risk assessments have been completed and are reviewed.

- The full amount of the funding has been spent.
